2011 Easter Campaign: "Satu Keluarga, Satu Buku Cerita Alkitab"

Recently Wawasan Penabur launched the "Satu Keluarga, Satu Buku Cerita Alkitab" (One Family, One Bible Story Book) on 26th March 2011, at St Paul's Church PJ. Alfred Tais in his opening speech mentioned that we are not able to import Christian books from Indonesia since 1980s, due to restriction from the Government especially where 'Allah' issue is concerned.

Our future generations (children & youth) will grow up without much Christian materials to help them grow spiritually. They probably know Islam better than their own religion as that's what they have been exposed to every day in school and thru mass-media. That's why there is a need to create awareness among Christian parents of their role and responsibilities in bringing up





The campaign was launched by Pr. Sam Ang, NECF Secretary General. He stressed that Malaysian churches, particularly the BM-speaking churches, in dire need of more resources, especially when the church is facing tremendous challenge with the latest stamping of 35,100 Alkitab, and other restrictions.

He then launched the "101 Cerita-Cerita Dari Alkitab" family book that was published specifically for this campaign. The gathering ended with approx. 1 hour of intercessions for the nation lead by various church leaders across denominations.

To make this campaign a success, you could play your role by:

- (1) Explain the purpose of the campaign each time you give away "101 Cerita-Cerita dari Alkitab" to the stakeholders. Explain to your congregation of their responsibilities in bringing up the next generation of children & youth that will know and love God.
- 2) Encourage the parents in your church to use the book in setting up their family altar, to build up the faith of their children right from the early years. This will prevent them from being attracted to other religion particularly Islam, and begin to be rooted in the Word of God thru the Bible stories.



- (3) You and your church could also sponsor the books so that they can be disseminate to the kindergartens, children homes, long houses and churches in the interior of Sabah & Sarawak, and the Orang Asli Ministry.
- (4) Take time to pray for the campaign this Easter. Ask the Lord to use this family book as a seed of revival in Bahasa-speaking Christian families.

May the Lord bless your ministry among the Bahasaspeaking Christians and families.


